Limits of NAVAREA XIII: from the border between North Korea and Russia (Inland) along the 42°17'.6N parallel to 42°17'.6N 135°00'.0E, from 42°17'.6N 135°00'.0E to 45°00'.0N 138°20'.0E, along the 45°00'.0N parallel to 45°00'.0N 180°00'.0, further following the International Date Line to 67-00'.0N parallel, then west to Russian coastline.

SafetyNET NAVAREA XIII warnings are transmitted twice a day at 0930 and 2130 UTC via INMARSAT POR satellite.
